### Answer Quiz #1

These are good summaries of all the kind of sins that we confess here at ABC. But why do we do that. We are under grace and so we believe all our sins have been forgiven, washed away as if they never existed. At ABC we believe that we need to repent, acknowledge the fact even though God has already forgiven us. We don't need to ask forgiveness. That is all true but it does not explain why it is a sin since there is no law to transgress.

The answer is Rom 14:23. Everything that is not of faith is a sin.

#### Review of Question 1

How can you sin if you are under grace, there is no law to transgress.

The answer to Question #1 is Rom 14:23. Everything that is not of faith is a sin Rom 4:15 for where no law is, [there is] no transgression.

### Question #2

How is that possible? Under the Age of Grace, there is no law, so how can Rom 14:23 be true?

### Answer #2

Gal 3:11 The just shall live by faith. This is a law. If you break this law, you are sinning.

Rom 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Gal 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, [it is] evident: for, The just shall live by faith.

Heb 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith: but if [any man] draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.

Hab 2:4 Behold, his soul [which] is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.

### Question #3

How can Gal 3:11 be a law under Grace?

### Answer #3

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: [it is] the gift of God:

It does not say that under the Age of Grace, there is no law. It says that under grace (which is for a given person who must be a believer) there is no law.

To understand this, we must differentiate between living in the Age of Grace and being "Under Grace."

Every person on earth is living in the Age of Grace, It is a period of time.

Believers enter under grace when they become born again. They are saved by grace **through Faith**. They are born again because of acting in faith.

Having started by faith, they must continue in faith.

Gal 3:23 But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed.

Gal 3:2 This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

Gal 3:3 Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

To be under grace, one must act by faith because grace is released by faith.

Without faith, there is no grace; without grace, you re under the law; and breaking the law is sin.

Rom 4:16 Therefore [it is] of faith, that [it might be] by grace;

#### Question 4

What happens if you do not walk in faith and commit a sin?

#### Answer 4

If you break the law, you have committed a sin.

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

You confess your sins but it is a temporary fix. The more frequently you confess the better.

#### Question 5

How is it possible to act in faith all the time so as to be under grace all the time?

#### Answer 5

Gal 5:18 But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

Rom 8:1 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

Rom 8:4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Rom 8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded [is] death; but to be spiritually minded [is] life and peace.

Question #6

How is it possible to be led by the Spirit at all time?

Answer #6

Affirm 1 Cor 2:16.

Protect your mind as the Mind of Christ.
